Tenor (T): RRLRRRLRRLRRLRRLL, then RRLRRRLRRLRRLRRLL. Measures end with >> >> >> >> >>.

Bass (B): R L R R R R L, dynamic *mf*, then R L R R R R L. Measures end with > > > > > > > >.

Cello (C): Measures show a pattern of eighth and sixteenth notes with various rests and dynamics, ending with a forte dynamic *f*.
